

“Anaconda”

The first great bass serpent to be built for 150 years was completed in June 1990 in our workshops and we believe it to be the largest wind instrument in the world. This a double-size bass serpent in C and it played an essential part in the serpent's 400th birthday celebrations at St John's Smith Square, London, in 1991. This instrument is now resident in the USA whilst the second anaconda to emerge from CM Instruments has remained in the UK.
